Dean's work has been chosen for the coveted **Leeuwin Estate Art Series** wine labels. His painting appears on the label for the Cabernet Sauvignon 2001, on current release.

In 2004 he was commissioned by the **National Portrait Gallery** to paint Sir Gus Nossal AC, distinguished scientist and Australian Of the Year 2001.

His work will be included in the forthcoming book ***Unfinished Journeys*** edited by Professor Jenny Zimmer and arts manager Ken McGregor, published by Macmillan Press (release date 2006).
