

Kyle Hughes-Odgers is a multi-disciplinary artist born in Perth Australia, 1981. He is well-known for his unique figurative and abstract based works.

Kyle Hughes-Odgers originally began creating artwork on the street across cities in Australia during the early 2000's. Progressing his work both on and off the street, Kyle held his first major solo exhibition with Turner Galleries in Perth Western Australia, 2010. This launched a path of exhibitions and public art commissions across the world - including solo exhibitions in Berlin, Amsterdam, Madrid and Los Angeles. His work is held in numerous private and public collections worldwide.

In addition to his exhibition works, Kyle has worked on public art projects internationally and has created large scale murals in New York City, Washington DC, Los Angeles, London, Sheffield, Hong Kong, Singapore, Madrid, Berlin, Cambodia and at home in Australia including the gigantic work 'From Above' a 6m x 80m exterior painting for the Perth International Airport.

In 2013 Kyle Hughes-Odgers and Meg Mckinlay (Author) won the SCBWI Crystal Kite Award for Australia/New Zealand for the children's book Ten Tiny Things published through Fremantle Press. He currently has 5 children's books published in Australia, New Zealand, Spain and China.
